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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2306 of Title 12, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	There shall be a rebuttable presumption that a statement
19	appearing on a social media posting or other electronic
20	communication attributed to a person testifying is the statement of
21	that individual. This presumption may be rebutted by a credible
22	denial under oath.
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SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2011, Section 60.1, as
 amended by Section 2, Chapter 200, O.S.L. 2019 (22 O.S. Supp. 2020,
 Section 60.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 60.1. As used in the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act
and in the Domestic Abuse Reporting Act, Sections 40.5 through 40.7
of this title, and Section 150.12B of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
Statutes:

Number of this act, a casual acquaintance or social context shall not constitute
 between persons in a business or social context shall not constitute
 a dating relationship;

2. "Domestic abuse" means any act of physical harm, or the
threat of imminent physical harm which is committed by an adult,
emancipated minor, or minor child thirteen (13) years of age or
older against another adult, emancipated minor or minor child who is
currently or was previously an intimate partner or family or
household member;

19 3. "Family or household members" means:

- 20 a. parents, including grandparents, stepparents, adoptive
 21 parents and foster parents,
- b. children, including grandchildren, stepchildren,
 adopted children and foster children, and
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- c. persons otherwise related by blood or marriage living in the same household;
- "Foreign protective order" means any valid order of 3 4. 4 protection issued by a court of another state or a tribal court; 5 5. "Harassment" means a knowing and willful course or pattern of conduct by a family or household member or an individual who is 6 or has been involved in a dating relationship with the person, 7 directed at a specific person which seriously alarms or annoys the 8 9 person, and which serves no legitimate purpose. The course of 10 conduct must be such as would cause a reasonable person to suffer 11 substantial emotional distress, and must actually cause substantial distress to the person. "Harassment" shall include, but not be 12 limited to, harassing or obscene telephone calls in violation of 13 Section 1172 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and fear of death 14 15 or bodily injury. Harassment can occur through social media or 16 other electronic communication and may include, but not be limited to, the use of social media or other electronic communication to: 17 post abusive or threatening messages that endanger the 18 a. physical wellbeing or safety of the person or 19 20 immediate family of the person, b. post or disseminate sensitive, private or embarrassing 21 information without consent of the person, 22 23

4	<u>d</u> .	create or utilize a fake account or profile to acquire
5		private information with the intent to threaten or

7	6. "In	timate partner" means:
8	a.	current or former spouses,
9	b.	persons who are or were in a dating relationship,
10	с.	persons who are the biological parents of the same
11		child, regardless of their marital status or whether
12		they have lived together at any time, and
13	d.	persons who currently or formerly lived together in an
14		intimate way, primarily characterized by affectionate
15		or sexual involvement. A sexual relationship may be
16		an indicator that a person is an intimate partner, but
17		is never a necessary condition;
18	7. "Mu	tual protective order" means a final protective order or
19	orders issu	ed to both a plaintiff who has filed a petition for a
20	protective	order and a defendant included as the defendant in the

22 domestic violence, stalking, harassment or rape against each other.
23 If both parties allege domestic abuse, violence, stalking,

plaintiff's petition restraining the parties from committing

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1 harassment or rape against each other, the parties shall do so by 2 separate petition pursuant to Section 60.4 of this title;

3 8. "Rape" means rape and rape by instrumentation in violation of Sections 1111 and 1111.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 4 5 9. "Stalking" means the willful, malicious τ and repeated following or harassment of a person by an adult, emancipated minor, 6 or minor thirteen (13) years of age or older, in a manner that would 7 cause a reasonable person to feel frightened, intimidated, 8 9 threatened, harassed, or molested and actually causes the person 10 being followed or harassed to feel terrorized, frightened, 11 intimidated, threatened, harassed or molested. Stalking also means 12 a course of conduct composed of a series of two or more separate acts over a period of time, however short, evidencing a continuity 13 of purpose or unconsented contact with a person that is initiated or 14 continued without the consent of the individual or in disregard of 15 the expressed desire of the individual that the contact be avoided 16 or discontinued. Unconsented contact or course of conduct includes, 17 but is not limited to: 18

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- following or appearing within the sight of that a. individual, 20
- b. approaching or confronting that individual in a public 21 place or on private property, 22
- appearing at the workplace or residence of that 23 с. individual, 24

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1		d.	entering onto or remaining on property owned, leased
2			or occupied by that individual,
3		e.	contacting that individual by telephone,
4		f.	sending mail or electronic communications to that
5			individual, or
6		g.	placing an object on, or delivering an object to,
7			property owned, leased or occupied by that individual;

9	10.	"Vic	tim support person" means a person affiliated with a
10	domestic	viol	ence, sexual assault or adult human sex trafficking
11	program,	cert	ified by the Attorney General or operating under a
12	tribal go	overn	ment, who provides support and assistance for a person
13	who files	ар	etition under the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act.
