L5	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be									
16	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:									
L7	The Legislature finds that adequate personnel are critical to									
18	ensuring railroad operational safety, security, and, in the event of

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1 reducing the risk exposure to local communities and protecting 2 environmentally sensitive or pristine land and waterways.

- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 104 of Title 66, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Should railroads, excluding short lines, operating within this state ever institute a policy requiring only a one-person crew in the control compartment of the lead locomotive unit of a train, then this section shall immediately become effective and require said railroads to have a minimum of two crewmembers in the control compartment of the lead locomotive unit of a train.
- B. Compliance with subsection A of this section shall not be required during switching operations, brake testing, safety inspections or while performing setouts in conjunction with road service.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
