13 14	An Act relating to veterans; amending 72 O.S. 2021, Section 63.2, which relates to members of the Oklahoma Veterans Commission; directing certain					
15	action within specific time frame and manner; updating statutory language; and providing an					
16	effective date.

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:					
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 72 O.S. 2021, Section 63.2, is					
20	amended to read as follows:					
21	Section 63.2. A. The Oklahoma Veterans Commission shall					
22	consist of nine (9) members all of whom shall be honorably					
23	discharged veterans; provided, one of the members shall be a veteran					
24	of the Vietnam Conflict and two shall be veterans of the Persian					

1 The members shall be selected in the following manner: The state executive board or committees of the veterans' organizations named in this section shall each submit to the 3 Governor a list of five persons qualified to serve as members of the 4 5 Oklahoma Veterans Commission. All appointments shall be broadly representative of the veterans of this state in terms of age, 6 gender, and race or ethnicity. The list shall be submitted to the 7 Governor not later than three (3) months prior to the expiration of 9 the terms of office of the members of the Oklahoma Veterans Commission. The Governor shall name one member from each of the 10 following Veterans' groups: the American Legion; the 11 Veterans of Foreign Wars; the Disabled American Veterans; the 12 13 Paralyzed Veterans of America; the Military Order of the Purple Heart; and the National Guard Association of Oklahoma. The members 14 representing the American Legion and the Paralyzed Veterans of 15 America shall take office no later than July 1, 2015. The members 16 representing the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Military Order of 17 the Purple Heart shall take office no later than July 1, 2016. 18 members representing the Disabled American Veterans and the National 19 Guard Association of Oklahoma shall take office no later than July 20 1, 2017. The Governor shall also appoint three members at large. 21 The executive officer of each veterans' organization 22 operating within this state shall, on or before January 1 of the 23 year in which the organization's appointee's term expires, submit to 24

the Secretary of State, the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a copy of the performance audit and the financial audit of the organization for the immediately preceding fiscal year of the organization. audits shall be conducted in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States and shall clearly show the total paid membership of the organization and shall be certified to by a certified public accountant. Failure to comply with this section shall render the organization ineligible to submit a nominee to the Governor. The members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Governor with advice and consent of the Senate, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. When a vacancy on the Oklahoma Veterans Commission occurs, the organization which is represented by the vacant position shall submit a list of five names to the Governor within thirty (30) days. The Governor shall choose a replacement from that list. No person shall be appointed by the Governor who is related by affinity or consanguinity within the third degree to any person employed by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs.

C. Before any member appointed as provided herein shall enter upon his or her duties as a member of the Commission, he or she shall take and subscribe to the oath of office as required by the Constitution of this state.

<u>D.</u> Present members of the Commission shall continue in office until the expiration of their terms and until their successors are appointed and enter upon the duties of their offices. Appointments shall be made for a three-year period. Any vacancy on the Commission resulting from any cause shall be filled by appointment by the Governor for the remainder of the term <u>as provided pursuant</u> to the provisions provided in <u>subsection B of</u> this section.

E. No member of the Oklahoma Veterans Commission shall be employed by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs during the time of his or her service on the Oklahoma Veterans Commission nor shall any person who served as a member of the Oklahoma Veterans Commission be employed by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs subsequent to his or her service on the Commission for a period of two (2) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
