16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

19	Bill of Rights".							
20	B. The purpose of the Women's Bill of Rights is to bring							
21	clarity, certainty, and uniformity under the laws of this state with							
22	respect to humans of both biological sexes and the manner in which							
23	they are treated as such under the laws of this state. All laws

2	hereby superseded and interpreted to the extent necessary by this							
3	act, including, but not limited to, any educational benefits,							
4	corrections housing, employment protections, and civil rights laws

6	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2021, Section 16, is							
7	amended to read as follows:							
8	Section 16. The word "person," As used in the Oklahoma

10	1. "Father" means the male parent of a child or children as							
11	defined in Section 7 of this title;							
12	2. "Female" means a human whose biological reproductive system							
13	is developed to produce ova;							
14	3. "Male" means a human whose biological reproductive system is

1 Section 1101. A. This act provides for exclusive remedies 2 within the state of the policies for individuals alleging discrimination in employment on the basis of race, color, national 3 4 origin, sex, religion, creed, age, disability or genetic 5 information. 6 This act shall be construed according to the fair import of Β. 7 its terms to further the general purposes stated in this section and the special purposes of the particular provision involved. 8 9 C. Any policy, program, or statute that prohibits sex discrimination shall be construed to forbid unfair treatment of 10 females or males in relation to similarly situated members of the 11

12 opposite sex. The state or its political subdivisions shall not be

13 prohibited from establishing distinctions between sexes when such

15 objective, including, but not limited to, biology, privacy, safety,

23 1. "Discriminatory practice" means a practice designated as 24 discriminatory under the terms of this act; 2. <u>"Equal", with reference to sex as defined in Section 16 of</u>
 <u>this title, shall not be construed to mean same or identical, and to</u>
 <u>differentiate between the sexes shall not necessarily be construed</u>
 <u>to be treating the sexes unequally; and</u>

5 <u>3.</u> "National origin" includes the national origin of an
6 ancestor; and.

3. "Person" includes an individual, association, corporation,
joint apprenticeship committee, joint-stock company, labor union,
legal representative, mutual company, partnership, receiver, trust,
trustee, trustee in bankruptcy, unincorporated organization, any
other legal or commercial entity, the state, or any governmental
entity or agency.

SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1202 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The state, any political subdivision, or any state agency or department, including, but not limited to, public school districts, that collects vital statistics for the purpose of gathering accurate public health, crime, economic, or other data shall identify any human who is part of the collected data as either male or female as defined in Section 16 of Title 25 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
