14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified							
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-401 of Title 2, unless there							
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:							
18	A. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry							
19	shall operate an Oklahoma Local Food for Schools program for the							
20	purpose of facilitating purchases of local foods by school							
21	districts.							
22	B. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry							
23	shall encourage school districts to partner with local producers and

- C. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry is authorized to promulgate emergency and permanent rules, as necessary, to carry out the provisions of this act.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-402 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be 10 11 designated the "Oklahoma Local Food for Schools Revolving Fund". 12 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year 13 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the 14 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from 15 legislative appropriations for the purpose of facilitating purchases 16 of local food by school districts. All monies accruing to the 17 credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be expended by 18 the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry for the 19 purpose provided for in Section 1 of this act. Expenditures from 20 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer 21 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the 22 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and 23 payment.
