clear and convincing evidence exists establishing that the defendant

was convicted of an offense that the defendant did not commit. The district court shall have jurisdiction and authority to consider, hear, and decide the motion. Any such determination made by the district court shall include findings of fact and conclusions of law.

B. If the case has previously been ruled upon by the Court of Criminal Appeals at any stage, then any appeal of the resolution of such motion shall be filed in the Oklahoma Supreme Court, which shall have jurisdiction to decide the appeal. The district attorney shall have the authority to prosecute such an appeal.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
