| An Act relating to schools; permitting board of education to establish fund to purchase high- |
| deductible property insurance policy; requiring transfer of monies from school district general fund; |

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| BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: |
| SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified |
| in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-117.7 of Title 70, unless |
| there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: |
| A. Pursuant to the powers and duties granted by paragraph 8 of |
| subsection A of Section 5-117 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, |
| the board of education of each school district may establish a |
| casualty and flood insurance recovery fund for the purpose of |
| purchasing a high-deductible property insurance policy. |
| B. Monies for the casualty and flood insurance recovery fund |
| shall be transferred from the school district general fund, as |
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| 1 | defined in Section 1-117 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The |
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| 2 | amount of monies transferred from the general fund shall not exceed |
| 3 | the amount of the high-deductible property insurance policy |
| 4 | deductible. |
| 5 | SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024. |
| 6 | SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation |
| 7 | of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby |
| 8 | declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and |
| 9 | be in full force from and after its passage and approval. |
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
