18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

 - Be a teacher with at least three (3) years of prior teaching experience and a valid or expired teaching certificate issued by:
 - the State Board of Education, a.

- b. the education certification entity of another state,
- C. the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards, or
- the education certification entity of another country; d.
- 2. Have not been employed by an Oklahoma public school district within the past five (5) years at the time of applying;
- Agree to be a full-time public school teacher in the state 3. for a minimum of five (5) years;
- Submit proof of his or her most recent teaching employment which may include a paystub or letter from the school district superintendent or board of education;
- 5. Submit proof provided by the school district where the applicant will be employed as a full-time teacher; and
- 6. Any additional requirements established by the State Board of Education.
- 23 The signing bonus shall be paid in five (5) equal annual installments of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00) per year for a

Req. No. 9889 Page 2 period of five (5) years. The total amount of the signing bonus shall not exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) per participant. Upon verification required by subsection E of this section, each installment of the signing bonus shall be paid to participants no later than September 1 of each year or within thirty (30) days of the first day of school, whichever is earlier. If an applicant is approved to participate in the signing bonus program after the school year has started, the signing bonus shall be prorated for the first year based on the percentage of days the participating teacher is contracted to work.

- E. 1. Prior to payment of any signing bonuses, the Department shall verify all of the information submitted by the applicant pursuant to subsection C of this section is accurate and confirm the applicant is eligible to participate in the signing bonus program.
- 2. Prior to the beginning of each school year after the teacher's first year participating in the signing bonus program, the teacher shall provide verification to the Department that the teacher continues to be eligible for the signing bonus program, including documentation from the Oklahoma school district where the teacher is employed full time.
- F. Any signing bonus paid pursuant to the Return to Teach
 Signing Bonus Act shall not be included in the calculation of salary
 for purposes of meeting the district or statutory minimum salary

schedule or for purposes of calculating Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma contributions or benefits. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to implement G. the provisions of the Return to Teach Signing Bonus Act. SECTION 2.
