10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 85.45j.11,
12 is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 85.45j.11. A. There is hereby created the "Oklahoma
14 Supplier Diversity Initiative", which shall be a state-sponsored
15 supplier diversity program to provide a resource for state agencies
16 and private businesses to utilize diverse firms in procurement
17 opportunities to encourage growth in the economy of the state. The
18 program shall provide convenience for qualified and certified small
19 business enterprises and minority business enterprises in
20 contracting projects in underserved areas.

21 B. The program shall allow diverse business enterprises to
22 register with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services and
23 allow registered vendors to be automatically notified of
24 opportunities to do business with the state for specific

1 commodities. The program shall provide for simplified vendor
2 registration processes.

3 C. The program shall authorize the Oklahoma Department of
4 Commerce to develop a diversity certification program to qualify and
5 certify diverse business enterprises for the state.

6 D. To qualify for the program, businesses shall have less than
7 five hundred total employees, an annual revenue equal to or less
8 than Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) and be certified
9 as one of the following:

10 1. ~~An Oklahoma~~ A Department of Transportation Disadvantaged
11 Business Enterprise;

12 2. Any of the following entities certified by the United States
13 Small Business Administration:

14 a. ~~Woman-Owned~~ Women-Owned Small Business,

15 b. Minority-Business Enterprise,

16 c. Small Disadvantaged Business,

17 d. ~~Service-disabled~~ Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small
18 Business,

19 e. HUBZone Small Business Concern, and

20 f. 8(a) Business Development ~~Program~~ program;

21 3. A Native American-owned Business; ~~or~~

22 4. A Veteran-owned Business; or

23 5. An entrepreneurship certified and actively participating in

24 one of the following programs:

- 1 a. as a current tenant or a tenant within the last three
2 (3) years of a certified incubator pursuant to the
3 Small Business Incubators Incentives Act, or
4 b. as an active participant in the accelerator program
5 certified by the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement
6 of Science and Technology.

7 E. The Central Purchasing Division of the Office of Management
8 and Enterprise Services shall:

9 1. Amend the vendor registration process to require diversity
10 certification check off and size standard information; and

11 2. Create a search tool for all state agencies and public or
12 private entities to utilize to obtain contact information for
13 diverse firms for the purpose of promoting procurement opportunities
14 within the state.

15 F. On or before September 1 of each year, the State Purchasing
16 Director shall submit a report to the Governor, the Speaker of the
17 House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate
18 on the status of the percentile of state funds expended on contracts
19 awarded to a certified ~~Oklahoma~~ Department of Transportation
20 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise and all of the entities certified
21 by the United States Small Business Administration mentioned in
22 subsection D of this section in the preceding fiscal year. The
23 report may include related economic impacts when applicable. The
24 report, statistics or other information concerning the participation

1 in the program shall be retained by the Office of Management and
2 Enterprise Services.

3 G. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall promulgate rules
4 to create and administer the Oklahoma Supplier Diversity Initiative.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
