9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to food; defining term; requiring  
11 certain compliance by licensed food establishments;  
12 directing promulgation of certain rules; providing  
13 certain immunities; providing for codification; and  
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1118.2 of Title 63, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. As used in this section, "cell-cultured meat", also referred  
20 to as lab-grown meat, cultivated meat, clean meat, in vitro meat,  
21 imitation meat, synthetic meat, and fake meat, means meat developed  
22 from animal cell cultures rather than through the traditional  
23 raising and slaughter of livestock. It does not include imitation  
24

1 meat made of non-meat ingredients including, but not limited to,  
2 plant-based protein.

3 B. A licensed food establishment shall not offer for sale any  
4 food or other product intended for human consumption that contains  
5 cell-cultured meat unless the establishment is in compliance with  
6 the rules promulgated under subsection C of this section.

7 C. The State Commissioner of Health shall promulgate rules  
8 requiring licensed food establishments that offer for sale any food  
9 or other product intended for human consumption that contains cell-  
10 cultured meat to disclose such fact to customers, including  
11 specification of any and all food or products that contain cell-  
12 cultured meat. The rules may, as deemed necessary and appropriate  
13 by the Commissioner, prescribe different requirements for different  
14 types of food establishments.

15 D. A licensed food establishment shall not be:

16 1. Penalized through fines, license suspension or revocation,  
17 or other administrative action by the Department; or

18 2. Liable for any civil damages,  
19 if the licensed food establishment makes a good-faith effort to  
20 comply with the provisions of this section and rules promulgated by  
21 the Commissioner.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
