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    extract that does not contain any synthesized kratom alkaloids,
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    other synthesized kratom constituents, or synthesized metabolites of
    any kratom constituent in which the level of 7-hydroxymitragynine,

    performance liquid chromatography testing method. For purposes of
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    this paragraph, "synthesized" refers to substances produced using
    directed synthetic or biosynthetic chemistry, as opposed to

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        3. "Vendor" means a person that sells, prepares or maintains
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    kratom products or that advertises, represents or holds itself out
