Hillyard Memorial Bridge; designating the C.D. 13 Scribner WWII Veteran Memorial Highway; providing for codification; and providing an effective date. 14 15 16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 1.7 A new section of law to be codified SECTION 1. NEW LAW 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.398 of Title 69, unless 19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 The section of State Highway 66 beginning at the intersection of 21 Country Club Road on the southwest edge of Bristow extending 22 northeasterly to the intersection of West 3rd Avenue in Creek County 23 shall be designated as the "Army SPC Ryan J. Grady Memorial 24

Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.399 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of Interstate 35 beginning on the south side of the State Highway 32 interchange extending north approximately seven (7) miles to the north side of the Oswalt Road interchange in Love County shall be designated as the "First MCPON Delbert D. Black, U.S. Navy, Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.400 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The intersection of U.S. Highway 60 and State Highway 18 north of Fairfax in Osage County shall be designated as the "Captain William 'Willy' Hargraves Memorial Intersection". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be placed at the intersection.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.401 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge crossing over Polecat Creek on U.S. Highway 75A south 1 of Sapulpa in Creek County shall be designated as the "Trooper Larry 2 L. Hillyard Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be 4 5 placed on the bridge. A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 6 SECTION 5. in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.402 of Title 69, unless 7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 8 The section of State Highway 48A beginning at the intersection 9 of Hollow Springs Road, extending east to the intersection of SH-48 10 in Coleman in Johnston County shall be designated as the "C.D. 11 Scribner WWII Veteran Memorial Highway". The Department of 12 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 13 name to be placed on the highway. 14 SECTION 6.
