16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:					
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified					
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4019.1 of Title 69, unless there					
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:					
20	A. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall conduct a					
21	study to determine the feasibility and costs associated with the					
22	construction of a new bypass highway in McCurtain County beginning					
23	west of Broken Bow on State Highway 3 extending north converging					
24	with U.S. Highway 259 near Hochatown. The Department shall create a

report with its findings. The report shall be distributed to the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representative and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate by January 1, 2025.

B. The Department shall not conduct any additional road-widening projects on U.S. Highway 259 within the city limits of Hochatown until the report is completed and distributed as required by subsection A of this section.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
