11	An Act relating to the Department of Human Services; making appropriations; identifying source;
12	establishing amounts; providing purposes; requiring and limiting the utilization of funds; creating
13	certain special accounts; limiting duration of accounts; requiring certain determinations; providing
14	and limiting the nature of accounts and the funds within the accounts; authorizing agency to submit
15	request for certain deposits or transfers; requiring certain compliance and verifications; authorizing
16	certain memorandums of understanding; limiting scope; prohibiting certain memoranda terms; authorizing and limiting the promulaction of rules and utilization of
17 18	limiting the promulgation of rules and utilization of procedures; authorizing and limiting the retention of monies for administration costs; requiring certain
	reports and submissions to certain entities;
19	requiring appearance before certain joint committee; limiting duration of certain requirements; providing

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23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
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1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the 2 Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled 3 House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma 4 5 Legislature, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to prepare more young adults with 6 intellectual and developmental disabilities or autism to live and 7 work independently. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner 8 9 consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee 10 on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 19, 2023.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of 11 12 Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled 13 House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma 14 Legislature, the sum of Ten Million Three Hundred Nine Thousand Nine 15 Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$10,309,911.00) or so much thereof as may be 16 necessary to enhance and increase capacity for programs assisting in 17 stabilizing justice involved women, their children, and caregivers 18 in the Tulsa area and into surrounding rural areas of Oklahoma. 19 Such funds shall be utilized in a manner consistent with the 20 recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief 21 Funding on May 19, 2023. 22

23 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of 24 Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the

1 Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma 2 Legislature, the sum of Three Million Eight Hundred Fourteen 3 Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$3,814,950.00) or so much 4 5 thereof as may be necessary to support and expand proven-effective programming for justice involved women in the Oklahoma City area and 6 into rural areas of Oklahoma. Such funds shall be utilized in a 7 manner consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint 8 9 Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 19, 2023.

10 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the 11 12 Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled 13 House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 14 (\$2,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to allow more 15 opportunities for working families with children, with and without 16 special needs, to obtain high-quality childcare. Such funds shall 17 be utilized in a manner consistent with the recommendations adopted 18 by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 19, 2023. 19 SECTION 5. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 20 Statewide Recovery Special Account for each appropriation section in 21 this act. The duration of such accounts shall continue for the 22 period of time that monies related to the American Rescue Plan Act 23 of 2021 are being budgeted, expended, or managed in the state. 24 The

1 ending of such period shall be determined by the State Treasurer, and shall result in the closing of such accounts as a matter of law. 2 Such accounts shall be continuing accounts as otherwise provided in 3 this section, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall 4 5 exclusively consist of monies related to the relevant appropriations made in this act and as otherwise directed by law. All monies 6 deposited to the credit of such accounts are hereby appropriated and 7 may be budgeted and expended by the Department of Human Services in 8 9 accordance with the provisions of this act. Expenditures from such 10 accounts shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the 11 12 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and 13 payment.

The Department of Human Services is authorized to request in Β. 14 writing that the monies appropriated by the provisions of this act 15 be deposited or transferred to the accounts created pursuant to 16 17 subsection A of this section. No later than seven (7) calendar days from the date of such request, the Director of the Office of 18 Management and Enterprise Services shall comply with such request 19 and verify to the requesting agency that such deposit or transfer 20 has been completed. 21

22 SECTION 6. The Department of Human Services may enter into 23 memorandums of understanding with other agencies of the State of 24 Oklahoma for the auditing, documentation, evaluation,

implementation, oversight, reporting, and management of funds and associated efforts related to the appropriations made in this act; provided, no such memorandum of understanding shall require or include, as an option or condition, the direct or practical transfer or relinquishment of control by the agency appropriated such funds to budget, expend, allocate, and request the distribution of the funds appropriated by this act.

8 SECTION 7. The Department of Human Services may promulgate 9 rules, utilize existing rules, establish procedures, and utilize 10 existing procedures to implement the provisions of this act, 11 provided such rules and procedures do not conflict with or impede 12 the provisions of this act.

SECTION 8. The Department of Human Services shall retain no more than two percent (2%) of the funds appropriated by this act to reimburse:

16 1. Costs incurred by the Department of Human Services; or

17 2. Costs incurred on the agency's behalf,

18 associated with the administration of the appropriated funds and 19 programming required by the Department of Human Services under the 20 provisions of this act; provided, no funds shall be retained that 21 would be disallowable under the provisions of the American Rescue 22 Plan Act of 2021.

23 SECTION 9. A. The Department of Human Services shall:

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Submit to the chairs of the Joint Committee on Pandemic
 Relief Funding, or any successor of the Oklahoma State Senate or
 Oklahoma House of Representatives legislative committee or joint
 committee, as designated by the President Pro Tempore of the
 Oklahoma State Senate and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
 Representatives:

- a. a written or electronic quarterly report detailing the
 budgeting, expenditure, and management of all monies
 appropriated in this act, and
- b. a copy of all memorandums of understanding and
 contracts with third parties entered into by the
 Department of Human Services to facilitate, assist, or
 administer powers and duties provided to the
 Department of Human Services under the provisions of
 this act; and

16 2. At the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding's request, 17 appear before the Joint Committee no later than six (6) months after 18 the effective date of this act, and as otherwise requested by the 19 Joint Committee to provide a status update regarding the 20 implementation of the provisions of this act.

B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall remain applicable for the period of time that monies appropriated under this act are being budgeted, expended, or managed in the state. The ending of such period shall be determined by the State Treasurer,

and shall be reported to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the
 Oklahoma State Senate, and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
 Representatives.

4 SECTION 10. For all projects funded in this measure, if a 5 nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization may help implement the project, the 6 Department of Human Services shall require the nonprofit show that 7 it:

8 1. Provides direct services to residents of Oklahoma;

9 2. Is in good standing with the Office of the Secretary of10 State;

Is in compliance with the applicable federal and Oklahoma
 tax laws for years 2019, 2020, and 2021; and

4. Continues to provide its good standing with the Office of
the Secretary of State and is in compliance with applicable federal
and Oklahoma tax laws for all years the nonprofit is helping
implement the program.

17 SECTION 11. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
