taught or inculcated in any of the public schools of this state, but
nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the reading of the
Holy Scriptures.
B. Private schools which receive state funds shall not use the state
funds to provide religious instruction or religious activities. Students
who receive state funds to attend private schools shall not be required to
