Research Analysis

The FA1 to HB1019 modifies the cap amounts for a 30-day and 90-day supply of insulin to an amount not to exceed thirty dollars (\$30) for a thirty-day supply and ninety dollars (\$90) for a ninety-day supply for each covered prescription.

FA1 also specifies that carriers that provide coverage for insulin are permitted to charge less than thirty dollars (\$30) per thirty-day supply or less than ninety dollars (\$90) per ninety-day supply.

Fiscal Analysis

According to officials at the Oklahoma Insurance Department, HB 1019 would create a minimal fiscal impact. The Rate and Form Division would review the contract, and if the Division was unable to identify a cap, then they would do a data call using an interrogatory template to verify the cap. If after that there were additional concerns OID could take additional steps including fines or targeted exams that ensure compliance.

Officials at the Oklahoma Health Care Authority were also contacted, and they do not believe HB 1019 in its current form would have a fiscal impact on them.

Therefore, as two State agencies most likely to be impacted by this measure do not believe it will impact them, the State's budget and appropriations should also not be impacted.

OID officials do not believe the Floor Amendment changes its analysis.

Officials at the Oklahoma Health Care Authority are unsure about any fiscal impacts the Floor Amendment may create.
