## **Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1082 provides a definition of "palliative care" as used in the Uniform Controlled Substances Act and requires the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control to create and make available reports regarding an annual change, plus or minus, of relevant de-identified data collected from the central repository rather than report findings directly to standing committees of the Legislature as current law dictates. The report must now include the number of prescriptions notated as acute and chronic in addition to the existing required information.

The measure also ensures that practitioners authorized to prescribe opioid drugs cannot face disciplinary action or investigation based solely on the average prescribed doses or quantities alone for an individual patient when the practitioner thoroughly documents their findings.
