Fiscal Analysis

Section 1 of HB 1611 repeals the Oklahoma Center for Rural Development Act. It appears this Center has been inactive for some time and was funded by a revolving fund. Eliminating the Center will have little to no impact on the State's budget or appropriations.

Section 2 of HB 1611 repeals the Rural Economic Development Task Force. It appears this Task Force has been inactive for some time. The Task Force was staffed by the House and the Senate, and it does not appear any funds were specifically designated to it. Eliminating the Task Force will have little to no impact on the State's budget or appropriations.

Section 3 of HB 1611 repeals the Oklahoma Commission on Interstate Cooperation. It appears this Commission has been inactive for some time, and its largest expense was refunding travel expense for members. Eliminating the Commission will have little to no impact on the State's budget or appropriations.
