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Bill Analysis

HB 1633 provides that a person incarcerated in a county jail shall be primarily responsible for payment of the cost of medical care provided to the person for any intentionally self-inflicted injury sustained while in the custody of the county. The person shall be charged for the medical care and treatment by the provider of the necessary care for self-inflicted injuries. The measure also provides that the custodial county may seek reimbursement from a person being held in custody and receiving medical care and treatment.

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
