**Bill Analysis**

HB 1681 prohibits any person from occupying campsites marked as “reserved” and provides for an administrative fine of \$50.00 to be levied on first time violators. The fine increases to \$100.00 and \$250.00 for second and subsequent offenses respectively. The measure also directs the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission to establish an annual single park pass for residents of this state in an amount not more than \$20.00. Residents aged 62 years or older shall remain exempt from parking fees. A nonresident annual single park pass shall be established in an amount not less than \$75.00.
