Research Analysis

The Conference Committee Substitute for HB1752 returns to the existing language that says a funeral director may execute a form prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election Board to notify the county election board secretary of the death of a county resident. The measure also adds that an order appointing a guardian shall set forth findings of fact as to whether the ward retains sufficient capacity to vote.

HB1752 sets a 30 day time limit for a county election board to remove deceased people from the central registry and voter registration list after receiving notice of a county resident death from the Secretary of the State Election Board. The measure additionally adds that an order appointing a guardian shall set forth findings of fact as to whether the ward retains sufficient capacity to vote.
