**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB1752 removes the requirement that a funeral director fill out a form prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election Board to notify the Secretary of the county election board of a county resident death by changing the shall back to a may.

HB 1752 sets a deadline of thirty (30) days from the date the list is received for the secretary of a county election board to remove the names of the deceased from the voter registration database. A funeral director may fill out a form from the Secretary of the State Election Board to notify the secretary of the county election board of a county resident's death.
