Research Analysis

The Floor substitute for HB1770 requires school districts to provide academic support for high school juniors and seniors who score below the benchmarks on the subject area portions of the ACT and SAT.

Academic support can be:

Extended instructional time during the day;
A summer academy;
Tutoring;
Online coursework; and
Repeating a course, among other things.

The measure prohibits students receiving extra academic support from being excluded in extracurricular activities or enrolling in CareerTech courses or programs.

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN INTRODUCED AND FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

The introduced version required "remediation". The Floor Sub requires "academic support".

The Floor Substitute adds language about excluding students from extracurricular activities.
