## **Research Analysis**

The committee amendment to HB 1927 alters the commencement time frame of foreclosure proceedings under this measure from 30 days after the lien has accrued to 20 days after the lien has accrued.

HB 1927, as amended, modifies the administrative process for motor vehicle liens in the case of a denial. The Notice of Possessory Lien and the Notice of Sale may be mailed on the same day in separate envelopes, but the Notice of Sale must be mailed after the possessory lien claimant has owned their property for at least 21 days. Additionally, if the denial occurred because of a submission error, the property owner will not be charged a subsequent resubmission fee.
