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**Bill Analysis**

HB 1936 provides that a school district shall reimburse a teacher who is certified and who, at the request of the employing district, takes and passes another subject area examination to teach an additional subject for the district. The reimbursement shall be equivalent to the cost of the subject area competency examination. The measure also directs the State Board of Education to allocate funds to districts to provide \$500.00 annual stipends to mentor teachers. The measure also requires a mentor teacher to provide guidance to a teacher in his or her first year of teaching at an employing school district, regardless of how long the teacher has been certified.

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
