Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 1950 requires the Secretary of the State Election Board to obtain official death records from the Social Security Administration and compare them against the state voter registration database. The CS also authorizes the Secretary of the State Election Board to obtain official death records from other states and then they must compare that data against the state's voter registration database. Any possible match will be transmitted to the secretary of the relevant county election board where they will ascertain any deceased voter and removed their information from the database. The State Election Board and county election boards must not release official death records in response to an Open Records Act request and must protect the data's integrity.
