**Research Analysis**

The second floor amendment to HB 2004 does the following:

- Increases the penalties for sales or purchases by a medical marijuana business to persons other than those allowed by law from \$1,000 to \$5,000 for the first violation and from \$5,000 to \$10,000 for any subsequent violation;
- Allowing the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) to order a licensee to immediately cease and desist operations when there is clear and convincing evidence that a public health or safety emergency exists;
- Prohibits licensed growers from transporting, relocating or selling any medical marijuana or marijuana plants that is the subject of an emergency order until the matter is resolved; and
- Provides that 50-percent-disabled veterans can pay a reduced biannual application fee of \$20.
