**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB 2048 prohibits insurers and pharmacy benefit managers from engaging in discriminatory practices regarding the reimbursements to 340B entities.

The Insurance Department and the Attorney General shall enforce the provisions of the Act. The Insurance Department is a non-appropriated agency, costs to the agency will be absorbed by the agency. The Office of the Attorney General believes they will need an additional three FTE to carry out the provisions of the act, with and total full year cost of those personnel to be \$410,000.
