**Research Analysis**

HB 2085, as introduced, would require the display of the national motto in all state buildings. Placement and size of the display would be prominent and in keeping with the display of the motto in the United States Capitol Visitor Center. The measure authorizes the Attorney General to prepare and present a legal defense of the display in the event its legality or constitutionality is challenged in court.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Previous analysis of similar legislation by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) resulted in an estimated cost of approximately \$250 per building to implement the provisions of HB 2085. OMES estimated 342 properties operating as state office buildings would be impacted by the measure; therefor, the measure's total cost to OMES is estimated to be \$85,500.
