HB 2153 lowers the property value limit in determining grand larceny from \$1,000 to \$750. The measure also provides that upon a third or subsequent conviction for petit larceny, the person is to be guilty of a felony.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure lowers the threshold amount that constitutes grand larceny and creates a felony upon third or subsequent conviction for petit larceny.
