Research Analysis

HB 2249, as introduced, modifies student eligibility to participate in sports after transferring schools.

The measure allows a student who transfers over the summer break to a school outside of their home district to participate in athletics beginning their first day attending the new school.

The OSSAA will determine a student's eligibility if the student transfers during the school year, or transfers more than once, and qualifies for a hardship waiver.

If a student transfers schools and is a dependent of an active uniformed military serviceperson, the student will be eligible to participate in sports beginning the first day of attendance.

If a student does not qualify for a hardship waiver, and does not transfer during the summer, they will not be eligible to participate in sports for their first year at the school.
