## **Bill Analysis**

HB 2458 authorizes the Uniform Retirement System for Justices and Judges (URSJJ) and the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) to release tax information of a deceased member to a person acting in a fiduciary capacity on their behalf for purposes of filing a tax return. The measure also provides that any actively participating member of URSJJ or OPERS who's first participating service occurred on or after July 1, 2013, and who works less than fulltime but has had at least 5 years of full-time employment during the 10 years immediately preceding retirement is not eligible to have their final average compensation calculated on an annualized basis.
