**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2461 expands the definition of critical infrastructure facility to include property within the State Capitol Park owned, leased, or occupied by the State of Oklahoma or any state governmental entity. In effect, the flight of unmanned aircraft and willfully damaging or trespassing on the State Capitol Park without permission is prohibited. Trespassing and damaging the State Capitol Park are punishable by fines and/or imprisonment as set forth in law.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2461 adds the State Capitol Park to the list of critical infrastructure facilities and prohibits flying unmanned aircraft on, willfully damaging, or trespassing on the State Capitol Park . This measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
