**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 2646 allows medical marijuana patient licensees to possess six mature marijuana plants and the harvested marijuana therefrom, as well as 72 ounces of topical marijuana. The amendment also divides processing licenses into nonvolatile and volatile categories, providing definitions for both.

The amendment authorizes dispensaries to prepare and package non-infused pre-rolled medical marijuana; the original language only specifies the packaging of pre-rolls.

Lastly, the amendment modifies the limits for test batches, harvest batches and production batches growers and processors must separate and directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to promulgate rules on testing final products, which are defined to include but not be limited to cookies, brownies, candies, gummies and chocolates.
