**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB2717 changes the income eligibility standards and payment amounts for the Family Support Program administered by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services. The income requirement is changed from \$45,000 or less to no more than 7 percent of the amount allowed by the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–193).

The amount of family support assistance payment is changed from a maximum of \$400 per month to being based on a sliding payment scale that is tied to income levels and the number of eligible children. Parents or legal guardians whose income is at or below the amount established in Public Law No. 104-193 may waive the payment amount based on the sliding scale and receive a \$400 monthly payment instead.
