## **Research Analysis**

HB 2745 changes the computation of the disability benefit for a member of the Oklahoma Police Pensions and Retirement System (OPPRS) who sustains an injury from a violent act in the line of duty. The measure directs OPPRS to compute the benefit by either using the compensation paid to the highest paid nonsupervisory patrol office in the employment of the municipality which employs the member or a 100-percent disability based on the member's final average salary, whichever results in the highest benefit.

HB 2745 amends the definition of *nonfiscal retirement bill* as used in OPLAAA to make the measure nonfiscal.
