**Fiscal Analysis**

Of the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125, specific appropriations are for:

- \$3,948,760.00 for annualization of the state portion of Medicaid rates;
- \$18,500,000.00 for the continuum of care for children in crisis;
- \$4,100,000.00 for implementation of potential consent decrees entered during the 2024 calendar year; and
- \$500,000.00 to maintain five pilot programs to provide offenders incarcerated in county jail in the State of Oklahoma access to certain approved medication assisted treatment.
