**Research Analysis**

House Bill 2929 appropriates \$3,948,760 for annualizing the state portion of Medicaid rates, \$18,500,000 for the continuum of care for children in crisis, and \$500,000 to maintain five pilot programs that provide medication-assisted treatment for opioid and alcohol dependence to offenders in county jails and upon release. This includes medical evaluations, FDA-approved medication, counseling services, cognitive behavioral therapies, and necessary staff.
