**Research Analysis**

HB3025, as introduced, allows court clerks to refuse payment of court fees if such payments are delivered in the form of loose coins in an amount greater than \$10. Alternatively, a clerk could ask the payor to count and roll loose coins valued at \$10 or more prior to accepting payment.
