## **Research Analysis**

HB 3171 prohibits the unlawful uses of drones to trespass on property with intent to eavesdrop or to do surveillance in a private place; install any device without consent to observe, photograph, record, amplify or broadcast sound or events in a private place; intentionally use a drove to observe another person in a private place where the person has a reasonable expectation of privacy; or land a drone on the property of another without the owner's consent. The penalty is a misdemeanor.
