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**Bill Analysis**

HB 3238 establishes the Oklahoma Health Care Authority as the state administering agency responsible for administering Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) program agreements. The Authority shall enforce the federal regulations of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services governing PACE. The measure exempts PACE organizations from licensure by the State Department of Health under the Home Care Act, the Adult Day Care Act, or any other act that governs a different type of facility or provider.

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
