Research Analysis

HB3252, as introduced, modifies the mission statement and duties of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce (ODOC) and the state's five-year economic development plan, which will be renamed the five-year infrastructure and community development plan. The measure removes ODOC as the state's official liaison agency for strategic economic development and business recruitment. Instead, ODOC will serve as a technical assistance resource for local communities seeking federal funding opportunities. ODOC is also directed to convene and working group of state agencies that includes ODOT, OWRB and the Oklahoma Broadband Office to maximize the investment of state and federal funds.
