**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3317 adds a requirement to the multidisciplinary elderly and vulnerable adult abuse team. Specifically, this measure adds that at least one multidisciplinary team member shall complete dementia-specific training on Alzheimer's disease and related dementia.

Upon review, this measure makes no changes to the provision that the authorized creation of multidisciplinary teams only occur subject to the availability of funding. Such changes modify the make-up of such teams, but do not directly effect funding levels for the program. This measure is not anticipated to directly impact the state budget or appropriations.
