**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3516 designates nineteen (19) new memorial highway and bridge locations in Oklahoma, as well as amends four (4) current designations in statute. Title 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the United States Armed Forces, Oklahoma Highway Patrol, peace officers, and first responders who were killed in the performance of their duties.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) currently estimates a cost of one thousand seven hundred and twenty dollars (\$1,720.00) per location that meets these qualifications, with one sign needed at each end of the designated highway or bridge.
