FA 1 to HB 3612 removes the requirement for the Department of Corrections to track the status of offenders whose execution of sentence has been held in abeyance and the requirement for the Department to notify the district attorney of pending release from federal custody.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure authorizes courts to hold execution of prison sentences in abeyance under certain circumstances. In its current form, HB3612 is not anticipated to have an impact on state budget or appropriations.

The FA1 to the measure removes the tracking and reporting requirements related to certain offenders for the Department of Corrections. It does not create fiscal impact.
