Research Analysis

HB 3641, as introduced, creates the Teacher Public Advocate Office within the Office of Educational Quality and Accountability. The Teacher Public Advocate, appointed by the Governor with Senate consent, will serve as a resource and advocate for public school teachers. They act as a liaison between teachers and the State Department of Education, offering guidance and support on professional matters, monitoring education policies, collaborating with stakeholders, conducting outreach programs for teacher education, and providing annual reports on the state of the teaching profession with recommendations for improvements.
