Research Analysis

The floor substitute for HB 3819 authorizes the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission to establish a continuing education program for construction industry workers affected by the codes adopted by the commission, code officials, and design professionals. Building trades professionals may attend training provided by the commission.

The measure also directs the commission to establish rules requiring proposed energy building codes or amendments to include a payback period of seven years or less or a statement explaining why a payback period is not applicable.

CHANGES IN FLOOR SUBSTITUTE FROM COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE:

The floor substitute removes the fee that may be charged to participants other than state-licensed code officials and the subsection establishing a workforce development process.
