**Research Analysis**

HB3838, as introduced, requires the Office of Tribal Relations within the Oklahoma Historical Society to organize its compilation of tribal compacts, agreements and documents in an electronic or paper format and deliver an updated copy of the collection to each member of the Legislature by December 1 of every even-numbered year.

**Fiscal Analysis**

According to the Oklahoma Historical Society (OHS), this measure will require the hiring of at least one additional staff person. Including salary and benefits, OHS estimates the cost of the additional hire to be about Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00). OHS is also considering the amount of time other staffers may need to devote to the requirements of this measure, and how it might change staffing levels. Therefore, the fiscal impact of this measure is at least \$75,000 per year.
