**Research Analysis**

House Bill 3862, as introduced, outlines procedures for implementing new prior authorization requirements, mandates adverse determinations be made by a qualified physician, and addresses the notification and discussion process with an enrollee's physician. The measure also places limitations on the revocation of prior authorizations, outlines conditions for preventive care, and specifies the criteria for granting, evaluating, and revoking exemptions. Non-compliance with specified deadlines and requirements will result in healthcare services being automatically deemed authorized by the utilization review entity.
