**Research Analysis**

HB 3972, as introduced, creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department State Park Emergency Maintenance Fund for the purpose of funding the Eight Year State Park Emergency Maintenance Plan. No more than 20 percent of the fund can be used to pay for operational purposes. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department is required to submit a report twice a year that identifies where the funds have been expended and the status of those projects. The report is to be sent to the Governor, legislative leadership, and the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission. This measure contains an emergency and will go into effect July 1, 2024.
